Abstract: In this talk, we discuss some opportunities for performing undergraduate research in math aimed at both faculty as mentors and students as participants. Specifically, I will explain some of the work I have done in number theory at Eastern including how the project began and progressed. The project involved a study of geometric objects motivated by number theoretic ideas called modular hyperbolas. We will discuss the results obtained and some open questions that other students may consider.
