EMPOWERING BLACK MALES IN THE MATHEMATICAL SCIENCES: INSIGHTS FROM A CRITICAL RACE SCHOLAR

Abstract: Broadening the participation of Black males in the mathematical sciences is of national concern, especially in light of the racial challenges thrust upon this group. Along with that, there are ongoing attacks and bans on Critical Race Theory (CRT) as well as scholars who do race-related work. During this session, the colloquium speaker will share relevant research and promising practices regarding the empowerment of Black males in the mathematical sciences. In so doing, he will draw insights from the CRT knowledge base and advocate for environments that improve the mathematics achievement outcomes for Black male students.
