LEARNING ABOUT STUDENT EXPERIENCES IN MATHEMATICS

<u>Abstract:</u> This talk will share preliminary data analysis from an ongoing survey study that seeks to understand student experiences learning mathematics. More specifically, this study is being conducted with the purpose of collecting more extensive and purposeful data to provide opportunity for further analysis of student experiences to more fully understand the prevalence of experiences that students find threatening to their mathematics disposition in order to better identify, treat, and even prevent the occurrence of math trauma (Gunter & Gunter, 2023).
